The standard construction of Sylko Metallic is one end of filament yarn, wrapped around with one end of metallised foil. Please be aware, for shade 19685 (antique silver), the construction is slightly different: it is made up of two ends of filament yarn wrapped around with one end of metallised foil. The actual grist, or optical thickness of the thread, and the recommended needle size is the same.

Thermal Properties

Melts at 250 - 260°C, softens at 220 - 240°C

Shrinkage less than 1% @ 150°C

Chemical Properties

Coats Sylko Metallic is made from a combination of filament yarn and precious metals. The resistance to any particular chemical will depend on the individual circumstances. Technical advice should be sought from your nearest Coats unit if the application involves chemical treatment.
